

THE EVOCATION OF NAMMU

The previous ritual I gave on GoMDE was a short ritual to call on Nammu.

This is a nice ritual, and I love it as much as the results I got with it.

I have, however, used more advanced workings.

The one I am revealing here is one of the main rituals I use to work with Nammu. It is an evocation, meaning that the presence of Nammu will come before you.

Many of you might feel a presence. Some others won't, but they will still get results. When I do this ritual, I see Her through my subtle sense.

And this is a part of the ritual that you should be aware of: It is made out of nine steps.

Each step is concise and consists of reciting a series of names of power obtained from Nammu Herself.

At the end of each step, you should pause for a single second and see if you can see, feel, or sense Nammu in any way, do not wait more than three seconds and carry on the ritual, knowing that when it is fully completed, you might sense Her. You will most likely recognize Her changing form, one way or another. When I do this ritual, Nammu appears under different feminine Goddess images that I've seen depicting Her after more than a year of working with Her magic. These images are different after each step, and in all cases, there are usually one or more times out of these nine steps when she appears as a more symbolic/abstract entity, like a star of white light, strange blue filaments with a center star, or even numbers with significance.

Should you not see anything, do not concern yourself with this matter. You might also feel Her, even feeling Her presence changing at each step, without seeing Her at all. And as always, some people might simply not sense anything. What matters is if the operation brings concrete results.

The names I've received are made to call upon Nammu.

After all this time, I have obtained many (thousands?) of those kinds of names from Nammu. I have noticed a pattern, a sort of linguistical melody.

These names often sound pretty and coherent within themselves, some syllables are recurring, and this was found in all of the rituals and power names I got for Nammu workings.

Most of these names have no actual meaning, although some made sense directly on occasion. In any case, this is usually what we call *nomina barbara*. Some of these names are short, some much longer.

I will provide my pronunciation at some point, but it is pretty straightforward, you can pronounce them as you read them, and as in many cases of *nomina barbara*, perfect pronunciation isn't vital. (And maybe doesn't even actually exist.)

Repeating the ritual in the same session is beneficial. Three times can be potent, seven even more. You can keep going as much as you want, as the power is definitely cumulative.

Now, here comes the real exciting part. What should you ask from Nammu?

She likes anything spiritual. It can be getting closer to the Divine, as She is an incarnation of the Divine (one of the purest I've encountered), spiritual/magical empowerment, being guided for your higher good, and bringing love and sincere happiness to you and anyone else.

You can ask for blessings, a powerful change in your life, or anything beneficial.

You can also ask for anything material she can deliver.

As a primordial Goddess, she encompasses any and every intent. I think anything spiritual,

magical, or benevolent, whether for yourself or others, is among the most important things for Her. Please, do work for other intents as you see fit. She is Nammu. She will decide.

Know also that you can't command Her. Like any Deity. You can only ask, make a request for your desire.

The Ninth Step is Her ultimate form. It doesn't mean it is the same for everyone or the only one you will ever see at that step. Know that secret.

EVOCATION OF NAMMU

"I welcome Nammu to this place.

For the first time, I evoke Nammu.

For the fourth time, I evoke Nammu.

Hooo miii ekna moustehrilarko minista ah ohmekneh rii oh meh nah kwa istarknou imesteh kina mouleh bih namouestehri iknasteh moulasleh nakna ohmanora ekna sta ohmistari nanikna innnastiranah.

For the fifth time, I evoke Nammu.

Nakneh nakneh ennesti Nammu lah imesteh rilako imsti kina ohnastikna omisterehneh mikneh mouesteh erneh osti nah milakna ohmistiriak ilmonosteh rilaki ahomnokina souminka ohmikna nasteh reh omikna nastereh Nammu.

For the sixth time, I evoke Nammu.

Imista kina roula omisteh kona mousta reknhi eknistiri lakoumastikreh ekna mousta rina kina osteh romisteh kina mousta la oukneh mouesteh rilakno inakno snikneh nira.

For the seventh time, I evoke Nammu.

Roula oukneh isti oukna moulasteh rina kwa ohmekhkehsti nah kla nou emesteh rila kouwi ohmesteh rikla oupla snaklou piklarsneh ohkina minirista ohmysterilakno ohmysterilakno ohmysterilakno ohmnesteh imisti kina koula poulakno.

For the eighth time, I evoke Nammu.

mysterilakomihounassa mikla Nammu steh ikna konami minaro stinkini animi niknikni istah nira

For the ninth time, I evoke Nammu ... Her ultimate form.

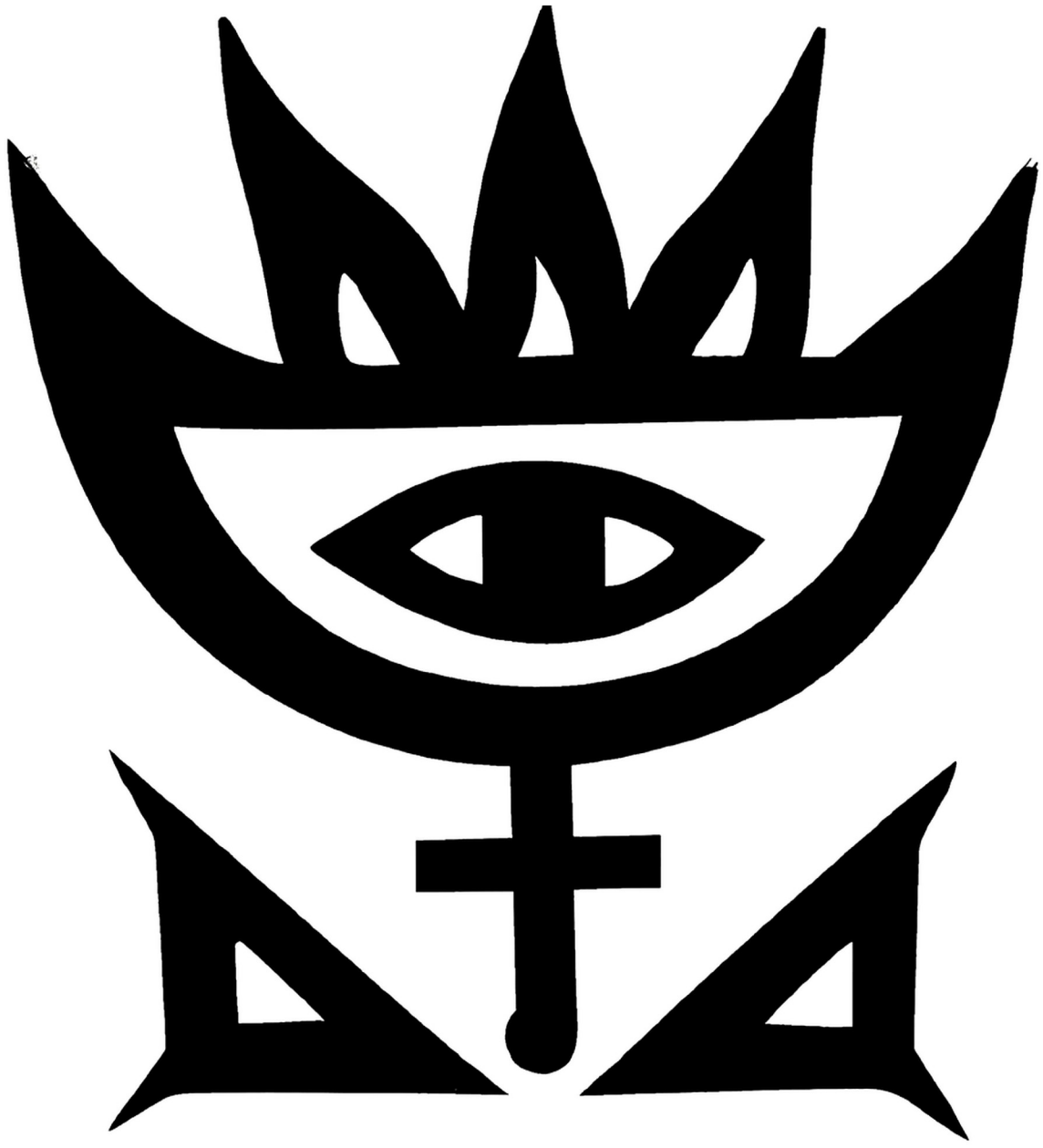
Ohkina nouru nastikna koumi eksneh komila kisni omila kni mista oh mista kinon morkleh oh

At this point, interact with Nammu, whatever you see, see it, whatever you feel, feel it, if you
don't feel anything, state your request to Nammu, feeling sheer gratitude, as if the result already
happened.

An offering of incense, Jasmin or other, at the end of the ritual, is a noble, profound gesture. If
you can't offer incense, simple offer gratitude to Nammu, and tell Her your reverence.

It is done.
